



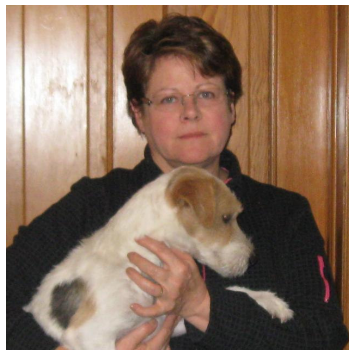

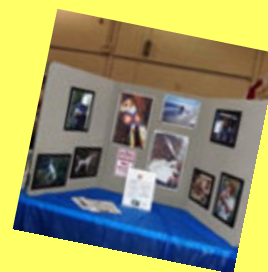

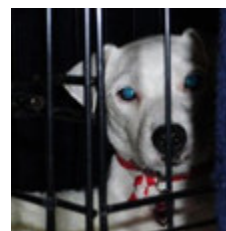

Jack Snacks

Peanut Butter Doggie Treats

1 1/2 cups whole wheat flour

1 1/2 cups white flour

1/2 cup organic peanut butter

1 cup water 2 tablespoons oil

Preheat oven to 350 F. Combine oil, peanut butter and water. Add flour one cup at a time forming a stiff dough. Knead into firm balls and roll to 1/4 inch thickness. Cut into 3-4 inch pieces. Ungreased cookie sheet . 350 F for 20 minutes.
